

BLACK BEAN BLOWOUT IRON CHEF STYLE!



Ybor City's Historic Black Bean competition returns, joining Fiesta Day with a new twist, Iron Chef Style. The competition will take place February 28th, 2009 in Ybor City as part of Fiesta Day.

Imagine a show with the theatrics of pro wrestling, the pace of a game show and the culinary expertise of Wolfgang Puck battling it out for 60 minutes.

The Black Bean Blowout will prove who the best chefs in the Tampa Bay area are. There will be two separate competitions, one for Amateurs and one for Professionals. When the timer sounds, chefs have 60 minutes to make their best edible black bean creations. At the end of the 60 minute time period their dish must be finished, plated, and ready for presentation. A panel of food critics and celebrity judges will sample and announce the winner! Along with this competition imagine an emcee extraordinaire and most importantly the winner walks away with a plaque, \$500 cash for Amateurs, \$1000 cash for professionals and bragging rights until next year.

Rules:

- **Entry fee for Amateurs is \$25.**
- **Entry fee for Professionals is \$150 (due to advertising purposes).**
- **Competition is limited to five (5) Amateurs and five (5) Professionals and is based on a first come, first served basis.**
- **Amateur Competition takes place between the hours of 11am and 12pm.**
- **Professional Competition takes place between the hours of 2pm and 3pm.**
- **Chefs must prep and cook black beans to their choosing before competition – the remainder of the dish must be prepared on-site at the event with the ingredients provided by the event staff.**
- **The “Secret Ingredients” for making your edible creation will be revealed on the day of the competition – with the exception of black beans, you may only use these ingredients which will be provided by the event staff.**
- **CC Event Productions, Inc. will have a selection of cookware, utensils and spices available (Quantities limited), but we encourage you to bring your own.**
- **CC Event Productions, Inc. will provide three (3) small propane burners per competitor for cooking.**
- **Chefs will have sixty (60) minutes to prepare their “Black Bean Creation” using only their own black beans and the ingredients provided by the event staff. At the sound of the final buzzer, all dishes must be finished and ready for judging.**

Suggestions/Disclaimers:

- Competitors are required to sign a waiver of liability. Participation in the event is entirely at the chefs’ own risk.
- All competitors consent to release the use of their photographs, biographies and names with regard to promoting the competition, event, CC Event Productions, Inc. and Ybor City.
- All decisions made by the competition committee are final.

Sportsmanship:

- The competition committee recognizes that the “Iron Chef” style competition can provide exciting entertainment for the audience and the thrill of competition for the participants. By entering, all participants agree that the competition aims to provide enjoyment for all and agree to act in a manner which is both sportsmanlike and reflects the intent of the competition at all times (before, during and after).
